In order to qualify for the grant, an applicant must:

1. Be a child of a member of the Orange County CTA.
2. Demonstrate financial need and possess high overall qualifications, including character and scholarship.
3. Submit a timely application.
4. Be eligible for graduation from an accredited high school.

Criteria for Applying

****Please Note**: Failure to provide any of the below could disqualify applicants.**

A. Official Transcript

An OFFICIAL transcript of school work through the first semester of the current year must be submitted, to include UNWEIGHTED cumulative grade point average and class standing for grades 9 - 1st semester 12th. **ONLY an official transcript will be accepted.** It must be signed by the registrar or counselor. This document can not be an academic involvement report or subject/grade printout.

B. Copy of SAT and/or ACT scores

C. Letter of Application

A letter of application is required to give more detailed information. This letter should include:

1. The name of the school of your choice, with whatever assurance you can give us as to your acceptance there (we do not limit our help to those attending four-year colleges).
2. A 200 word essay stating your purpose in attending this institution and your plans after graduation.
3. A list of your outside activities, such as church or community involvement, offices held, paying jobs you have had during out-of-schools hours.
4. A list of your membership in any school clubs and organizations.
5. Plans for financing the large remainder of school expenses with any arrangements you might have for earning the money (i.e. other scholarships, grants, summer jobs, etc.)
6. An identification of extenuating circumstances to demonstrate financial need.
7. List any honors received, and any grants, loans, and / or scholarships you have been awarded or for which you have applied.

D. Reference Letters

At least one letter of academic recommendation **and** at least one letter of personal reference are required. Any additional reference letters from employers, school, clergy, etc. will be considered.

E. Other

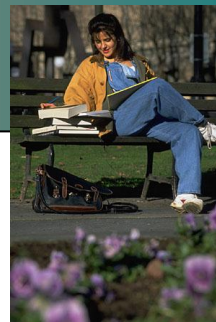
The Scholarship Committee may require an interview with the applicant or with the high school counselor.

Scholarship recipients may be asked to furnish a photograph for publicity purposes.

TO BE CONSIDERED:

- A. Incomplete applications will not be considered. It is suggested that all information be submitted simultaneously, including letters of reference.
- B. The completed application form and all attachments must be received in the CTA office no later than 6:00 p.m. on February 10, 2012.
